Summary

Government-led FCPF programme protecting 4.3M ha (2.7M ha forest) around Taï National Park. Delivered 7M tCO₂e verified reductions by 2024; World Bank paid US\$35M — first FCPF programme in Africa to enter the voluntary carbon market.
