

# Croatia Digital Nomad Residence Permit

## Summary

Croatia's temporary residence permit for non-EU remote workers, in force since January 2021 and extended to up to 3 years in 2025 — but MUP's own 2024 data show only 41.5% of applications approved, exposing a gap between policy ambition and delivery.
