

# Croatia's National Ministry-Funded AI-Text and Plagiarism Detection Infrastructure for Public Universities

Quality score: 53/100

Evidence strength: Observational / pre–post

## Summary

Since 2019/20 Croatia's Ministry has funded a national Turnitin licence via SRCE for all public universities; checks grew from 74,711 to 265,106 papers by 2023/24. A 2024/25 AI-text detector covers only English/Spanish, and SRCE warns it can't definitively prove AI use.
