CTIC Dakar, founded 2011 with OPTIC, the Senegalese government, World Bank/IFC and Orange/Sonatel, has supported nearly 4,000 project leaders and 187 companies whose cumulative revenue reached 5.66 billion FCFA (~\$9.4M), independently confirmed by World Bank reporting.
