Summary

Cyprus's capped digital-nomad residence scheme, launched with just 100 places in 2021, hit its enlarged 500-permit ceiling by 2023; government data show 518 permits active by mid-2025 and an estimated €10m in annual nomad spending, alongside documented local rent pressure.
