Czech Republic's EUR 3.95M National Recovery Plan-funded AIDIG project trains teachers at all school levels in AI integration using the DigCompEdu framework; Czech teachers recorded Europe's highest teacher AI adoption rate at 46% in the OECD TALIS 2024 survey.
