

Czech Republic's DIA Accessibility-Statement Monitoring: 25.8% to 15.7% to 56.6%

Summary

Czech Republic's monitoring body checked accessibility statements on 360-487 public-sector sites a year (2022-2024), finding compliance swing from 25.8% down to 15.7% before recovering to 56.6% in 2024, with over 40% still falling short.
