

Czechitas — Brno's Grassroots-to-National AI and Digital Skills Movement for Women and Girls

Founded in Brno in 2014 as informal 'Rails Girls' meetups, Czechitas has run 1,800+ courses for 76,000+ participants and added dedicated AI courses for women developers; 50% of requalification graduates move into tech jobs within six months.
