

DavrOn — Uzbekistan's AI Tax Assistant Built Into a 7.5-Million-User Tax App

Summary

Uzbekistan's State Tax Committee launched DavrOn, a trilingual AI assistant trained on an 11-million-character tax knowledge base, inside the Soliq app used by 7.5 million people. It joins a Face-ID system with 6M+ users; DavrOn itself has no published usage figures yet.
