

Deakin Emerging Technologies Microcredentials — Australia's Subsidised National AI Upskilling Pilot

Summary

Deakin University offers 60 government-subsidised places in a stackable AI/emerging-technologies microcredential (four courses for AUD 800 vs AUD 4,400) under Australia's AUD 18.5m national Microcredentials Pilot, which funds 76 courses at 34 providers.
