

DepEd–Microsoft Partnership Equips 1 Million Filipino Teachers with Microsoft Copilot

Summary

DepEd and Microsoft are rolling out Copilot to 1 million Filipino public-school teachers for lesson planning and admin tasks, building on 2026 training that reached 175,000+ educators. A related 21-week AI reading pilot (3,431 students) showed gains but lacked a control group.
