Pakistan's Ignite fund approved a Rs. 1.79bn DigiSkills 3.0 relaunch adding 'AI using Python' among 25 free courses, aiming to train 3 million people over 3.5 years, building on a programme certifying 4m+ Pakistanis, incl. 800,000+ women, since 2018.
