Summary

Kazakhstan's Supreme Court scaled an AI analytics tool, piloted for 1.5 years in four regions, to every court nationwide in 2026. It shows judges similar-case outcomes and drafts routine administrative rulings; the Astana pilot saw above-average settlement rates.
