Summary

A \$400M World Bank-financed programme bundles rural electrification with subsidised internet-connected devices in Madagascar, targeting 3.4 million new internet users; a ~\$24M digital-inclusion window has facilitated 664,000 devices, 400,000 earmarked for women and girls.
