Summary

Solar-powered digital centres in indigenous Guatemalan villages deliver digital literacy and leadership training to Mayan women and youth; a 2025 *Frontiers* study (n=43) confirmed significant skill gains ($p<0.001$) across four DigComp domains; 4,000+ women reached.
