Summary

UN Women and the Orange Foundation built Women's Digital Centers at Peace Huts in rural Bong County, Liberia; 45 women graduated a six-month digital/mobile-money course, adding to over 70 women hired as Orange agents and 700 using mobile money after 2022 trainings.
