

DNCP's AI-Assisted Anomaly Detection — Paraguay's Procurement Watchdog Flags Bidding Risks

Paraguay's procurement authority DNCP has run a government AI system since 2022 to flag bidding anomalies and predict corruption risk, reconfirmed active in 2025 by the Vice Minister of Technologies — though no detection-accuracy figures are public.
