

DRC Cuts National State-Exam Correction from 45 Days to 3 with AI-Assisted Scanning

Summary

The DRC's Ministry of National Education introduced AI-assisted scanning and correction for the 2025 State Exam, adding scanning centres in Mbuji-Mayi and Lubumbashi and cutting the correction cycle from 45 days to 3, with human inspectors retaining oversight.
