

DT4PAG — Disruptive Technologies for Public Asset Governance (Da Nang)

Summary

A World Bank/SECO-funded programme piloted city-specific digital governance tools in Da Nang, cutting a public-asset monitoring cycle from 34 to 11 hours and construction-permit approval from 10 to 3.75 days, with benefits estimated at 8x the pilot's cost.
