Summary

ECCB's annual Generative AI & Python Summer Camp trained close to 400 teens (13-18) across seven Eastern Caribbean islands in 2025, who built 21 working chatbots for real civic problems - funded jointly with Taiwan under the Bank's 'Big Push' digital-transformation strategy.
