

# Eesti.ai — Estonia's Government Office Programme to Scale AI Across the Public Sector

## Summary

Estonia's Government Office runs Eesti.ai, approving 15 public-sector AI projects by April 2026 atop 130+ existing deployments. OECD's own review says adoption still "remains concentrated" in ICT, and total budget was unconfirmed as of the source date.
