

Electronic Court Practice System — Montenegro's First AI Tool in the National Judiciary

Summary

Montenegro's Judicial Council built an in-house AI-based case-law system, piloted at the Commercial Court, to standardise court practice — backed by an EU-funded NVIDIA DGX H200 server, but with no usage or accuracy figures published yet ahead of a planned 2027 national rollout.
