

ENSIAS–ÉTS WCAG Audits — Diagnosing Accessibility Gaps Across Morocco's E-Government Portals

Quality score: 68/100

Evidence strength: Moderate

Summary

Two independent academic audits (2014, 2024) applied AccessiWeb and AChecker against WCAG 2.0 to Morocco's top e-government portals. The 2024 study logged 41–123 errors and 4–8 failed success criteria per portal, none fully compliant, feeding fix-lists to portal owners.
