Young Scientists Kenya trained 170 secondary-school teachers in Nakuru, Mandera, Tana River and Wajir counties to deliver the Raspberry Pi Foundation/Google DeepMind 'Experience AI' curriculum, reaching about 3,400 students within six months, funded by Google.org.
