

ExtrAct — Poland's AI Document-Extraction Tool for Municipal Notarial Deeds

Summary

Poland's Ministry of Digital Affairs piloted ExtrAct, an AI tool by the IDEAS institute that reads notarial deeds for municipal officials. Tested on 350+ deeds in Międzyzdroje, it hit ~95% extraction accuracy and cut processing time roughly five-fold.
