Summary

Mexico's first metropolitan water fund — corporate contributions from ARCA Continental, Heineken and CEMEX secure 2,796 ha under PES and ~9,000 ha rehabilitated in the San Juan watershed, protecting 60%+ of freshwater supply for 4 million Monterrey residents.
