Summary

France attaches an annual gender-equality budget document (DPT) covering about 48 programmes and €5.8bn, but the Cour des comptes calls its funding growth a 'trompe-l'œil' and IGF/IGAS finds ex-ante gender-impact assessments are almost never actually measured.
