

Future Ready TT — National ChatGPT Edu and AI-Literacy Rollout for Trinidad and Tobago's Schools

Summary

Trinidad and Tobago joined OpenAI's Education for Countries initiative (Jan 2026) and formalised 'Future Ready TT' (May 2026), rolling ChatGPT Edu and Grammarly into schools; a 550-licence public-sector pilot recorded 75% productivity gains, but no student data yet.
