Summary

A \$10M Green Climate Fund grant backing FAO-led gum-arabic agroforestry and rangeland restoration across Sudan's Kordofan states, targeting 275,000 hectares and 1.58 million beneficiaries, now proceeding amid the country's 2023 civil war.
