Summary

Italy's Salesian school network scaled a Gemini for Education pilot from 700 Triveneto teachers to 1,600+ nationally in a year; a Pontifical Salesian University study of 29,000+ students found +9% engagement, +16% creativity, and 69% of teachers reporting improved lesson planning
