Japan's Digital Agency built GENAI, a sovereign generative-AI platform deployed to all Agency staff in May 2025. One documented case cut a 2-month task to 3 days. Codebase released as OSS; large-scale pilot covering 180,000 civil servants across all ministries launched January 20
