Summary

A Sida-funded partnership between NIRAS/CPM and Ukraine's Ministry of Finance embedded gender-responsive budgeting nationally, lifting gender-tagged budget programmes from 6 to 1,075 and training ~3,000 officials; independently evaluated by Sida in 2023.
