Summary

Ghana's 2017 national digital-addressing system assigns a unique code to every 5m² of the country. Independent fieldwork cited by TechLabari found uneven adoption — 68% of owners vs 32% of renters in the Accra suburbs studied — and a non-functional emergency-service integration.
