GIFEC operates 157 ICT training centres across Ghana's 16 regions, serving students, youth, women entrepreneurs, teachers, disabled persons, and artisans. Since 2020: over 17,000 trained in Cisco-certified courses; 13,981 girls reached through the Girls in ICT initiative.
