WITSI's 2026 Girls in ICT Day in Honiara drew 200+ young women from 32 schools for an 'AI for Development' programme on disaster-response AI, an AI-for-Good challenge and cybersecurity, continuing an annual event first recorded with 150+ participants in 2021.
