Summary

ITU and Nepal's Telecommunications Authority ran a 2025 multi-city programme for girls 12–24 — a Kathmandu Valley launch, coding challenges in Butwal and Dhangadi, and an inclusive ICT workshop for girls with disabilities — covering AI, cybersecurity and data analytics.
