

# Girls to Code — Dhiraagu and Women in Tech Maldives' National Coding Programme

## Summary

Dhiraagu and Women in Tech Maldives' 'Girls to Code' has run island editions since 2019; the 2025 Male cohort graduated 17 women aged 16-30, for a cumulative 108, amid a national push - endorsed by the President - to bring girls into AI and digital development.
