

GovTech's AI Agent Registry — Singapore Extends Oversight to 150,000 Public Officers' AI Agents

GovTech Singapore announced in June 2026 a registry tracking ownership and permitted actions of AI agents used by its 150,000 public officers, building on Pair, its assistant already used by more than half the workforce — piloting now, wider rollout later in 2026.
