

Grassroots AI Adoption Under Crisis — Independent Surveys of Palestinian Medical Students and Gaza Teachers

Quality score: 27/100

Evidence strength: Descriptive / self-reported

Summary

Two peer-reviewed 2022-2025 surveys - 550 Al-Quds medical students, 264 Gaza teachers - document fast grassroots ChatGPT/AI adoption (87% of students use AI regularly) despite 91% lacking formal training, patchy access, and unresolved integrity concerns.
