

Grok Goes to School — El Salvador's Nationwide xAI Rollout Launches Without a Public Governance Framework

Summary

El Salvador announced a two-year plan to deploy xAI's Grok as a digital tutor to 5,000+ public schools reaching a million students, starting with a 100-school pilot in 2026. Reporters flagged the lack of any published child-data or moderation framework at launch.
