Summary

Guam combined a sequence of U.S. federal Digital Equity Act grants (\$150k, \$2.1M, \$2.5M) with a roughly \$5M BEAD broadband subgrant to fund Digital Navigator services, government accessibility upgrades, and fibre/satellite links for unserved island homes.
