

# Guatecompras — Guatemala's Mandatory National E-Procurement Transparency Portal

Evidence strength: Cautionary / limited

## Summary

Guatemala's Guatecompras portal has made e-procurement mandatory nationwide since 2004, but an independent World Bank audit found actual online disclosure averaged only 38% of legally required project information, weakest at the highest-corruption-risk stages.
