Founded in 2011 as 'Malagasy i-Hub' by independent web professionals, Habaka runs Madagascar's longest-standing tech coworking/incubation space, reporting support for roughly 80 start-ups and 70 trainings, and anchors a national push toward a 'Hay Valley' tech corridor.
