

HealthPulse AI Interpreter — Uganda's Blinded Pilot for AI-Assisted Malaria Test Reading

Summary

Uganda's Ministry of Health, with Medic and Audere, built AI malaria rapid-test interpretation into the national eCHIS across four districts; a blinded four-month Phase I found high agreement with Village Health Teams, though no percentages are published yet.
