

HEVPA — Chile's Re-education Centres for Men Who Exercise Intimate Partner Violence (Discontinued 2024)

Summary

Chile's SernamEG-run HEVPA centres offered group and individual intervention for men who used partner violence, 2011–2024. Fewer than 10% of the ~2,400 annual entrants completed it, and the government discontinued the programme in 2024 for lack of demonstrated impact.
