

Honduras ParticiPaz — Multi-Stakeholder Electoral Parity Programme Increasing Women in National Congress by Six Percentage Points (2020–2021)

Summary

Funded by the UN Peacebuilding Fund and implemented by UN Women, ParticiPaz trained 60+ women candidates in Honduras ahead of the November 2021 elections, yielding a 6% increase in women elected to the National Congress (reaching 27.3%) and a 45% increase in women's seats in muni
