Summary

A three-NGO consortium trains and mentors microentrepreneurs with disabilities, backed by an in-kind growth-kit and procurement links. 2,467 reached (84% disabled), self-reported income +35%; an LSHTM/KEMRI randomised trial is testing the causal effect.
