Summary

Indonesia's FCPF ERPA for East Kalimantan (signed Nov 2020) commits up to US\$110 million for 22 million tCO₂e; in Nov 2022, Indonesia received a US\$20.9 million advance—the first FCPF disbursement in East Asia & Pacific—for verified 2019–2020 emission reductions.
