

INFORDEPE & UNICEF Teach Timorese Teachers to Use ChatGPT for Portuguese Instruction

Summary

Timor-Leste's INFORDEPE and UNICEF trained teachers in Ainaro, Ermera and Liquiça in digital literacy from 2024 (US\$1.1m, 600-teacher target). By August 2024, 172 had ICT training and learned to use ChatGPT and Google to help students with hard Portuguese vocabulary.
