

Informe de Impacto de Género — Spain's Annual Gender Impact Report on the National Budget

Summary

Since 2009 Spain has screened every national budget programme for gender relevance — 372 of 379 rated gender-sensitive in 2023 — though economists call the exercise technically strong but largely 'window dressing', with no proven shift in real allocations.
